INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

The Bikeability Trust is working towards consistent training provision across the whole country and the qualification of instructors is therefore an important part of quality control. All registered Bikeability instructors must hold or be preparing for the **1st4sport Level 2 Award in Instructing Cycle Training**. Instructors with National Standard Instructor (NSI) status acquired under previous instructor training arrangements may continue delivering Bikeability but must register for assessment for the 1st4sport award before 1 April 2024.



We have a team of fully qualified tutors ready to deliver the L2AICT course at a venue to suit and we can tailor the course to requirements. For example as a 5-day course or split over two weekends.

We also deliver the Recognised Prior Learning (RPL) route to the L2AICT. Our approach to this process is to offer as much support to instructors as possible - we want to keep their knowledge and experience in the industry. When instructors register for the RPL route they attend a Bikeability Trust approved induction session. We are the only RDC to offer this session to support instructors.

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Bikeability Providers must ensure all instructors are formally observed and mentored annually. An established mentoring process is key in supporting a CPD programme. The Bikeability Trust will be encouraging instructors to engage in annual CPD and record this when they renew their registration. With over 200 instructors on our team we are experienced, enthusiastic advocates of CPD and offer range of opportunities to tutors, instructors and provider managers.

We have specific **CPD courses that are approved by the Bikeability Trust** and can also work with you to address the CPD requirements of your instructors delivering an annual package along with assessment and support for their development plans.

INSTRUCTOR SAFE RECRUITMENT

Over a number of years, we have developed our approach to the safer recruitment and training of instructors and have established a model which we could share and implement for Grant Recipients and Bikeability Providers.

We have recently recruited a cohort of instructors to BikeRight!, one of our Bikeability providers, and are in the process of skilling them up for delivering Bikeability sessions.



THE RECRUITMENT CONSULTANCY PACKAGE INVOLVES:

- Placing job advertisements in local, specialist and social media
- Selection of suitable candidates through application filtering
- Phone/video interviews using the RDC training and operations team
- Adult Cycle Skills assessment delivered by one of our course tutors
- Successful candidates are registered for the L2AICT course and supplied with course pre-learning materials

- Delivery of the L2AICT course and completion of tasks in advance of starting delivery of Bikeability sessions
- Emergency 1st Aid at Work and Educare Safeguarding training
- Basic cycle maintenance training
- L2AICT Post Course Assessment provided at an appropriate time within the qualification requirements



CONSULTANCY
